The International Va'a Federation is pleased to invite the membership of the IVF to participate in the 2020 IVF Va'a World Sprint Championships. The event will be held in Hilo on the Island of Hawaii.

The dates for the event will be from 15th to 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2020.

The schedule will remain draft until entries are confirmed. The racing program detail will be provided approximately two weeks prior to the beginning of racing.

The Online entries for the event will be done through the IVF web site, <u>ivfiv.org</u>. Area coordinators may use the 'Event On Line Registration' link under Events for the 2020 World Sprints. Online entries will be available from 1 January 2020.

Summary overview of each championship: IVF WORLD ELITE CHAMPIONSHIP

- Teams will be representing their IVF Member country/region
- Countries may enter 1 team per category.
- Countries may enter 2 V6 teams per Para category
- Only the following categories will be recognised:
- Junior Development (J19) male & female V6 500m & V6 1000m
- Elite (Open) male and female V6 500m & V6 1500m
- Para Va'a (Mixed minimum of 2 females per V6 & 4 females per V12) V6 500m & V6 1500m & V12 500m
- Countries may enter 1 x V12 team per gender (excluding Para Va'a)
- Countries may enter 3 x V1 paddlers per category (all categories J16 to M70)
- Countries can earn up to a maximum of 6 x V1 entries total based on the number of medalists in the previous World Sprints. One medal allows four entries, two medals allow five entries and three medals allow six entries. - Please note that V1 racing will take place throughout the Club Events racing.
- At the World Elite Championship, uniform should be a national uniform of the County/Region

## IVF WORLD CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- The number of entries allowed by each member in the World Club Championship event are as follows:
  - V6 events: 6 entries per category U16 to Master 70
  - V12 events: 3 entries per category U16 to Master 70
- Elite paddlers may participate in both Elite and Club racing
- Any Club team V6 may contain no more than 3 paddlers who participated in the World Elite Championship teams
- Any Club team V12 may contain no more than 6 paddlers who participated in the World Elite Championship teams.
- Each IVF Country/Region must confirm that the club teams entered are in fact made up of members of those bonafide clubs within their country. *Club teams are defined at the discretion of the IVF member country.*
- At the World Club Championship, uniform may be representative of the IVF member region or club.

## Entry Fees:

World Elite Championship: \$100 per paddler (US) World Club Championship: \$100 per paddler (US) Note : Elite paddlers who also paddle in the club event only need pay the 1 x \$100 fee. Note (2) V1 Paddlers who only paddle V1 – Only need pay \$100 (US fee)

50% of the fee will be due with Intent head count on March 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 and no later than 20 March 2020
